The term colonial history of the United States refers to the history of the land that would become the United States from the start of European settlement to the time of independence from Europe, and especially to the history of the thirteen colonies of Britain which declared themselves independent in 1776. Starting in the late 16th century, the Spanish, the British, the French, Swedes and the Dutch began to colonize eastern North America. Many early attempts— notably the Lost Colony of Roanoke— ended Colonial Period Timeline 1565: St. Augustine is founded by the Spanish. 1607: Jamestown, the first permanent English colony in North America, is established in Virginia. 1620: Pilgrims reach Plymouth, Massachusetts, aboard the Mayflower; "Mayflower Compact" adopted.
