## The Reflexive Medium

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In mathematics, a binary relation  $R$  over a set  $X$  is reflexive if it relates every element of  $X$  to itself. Formally, this may be written  $\forall x \in X : x R x$ , or as  $I \subseteq R$  where  $I$  is the identity relation on  $X$ . An example of a reflexive relation is the relation "is equal to" on the set of real numbers, since every real number is equal to itself. A reflexive relation is said to have the reflexive property or is said to possess reflexivity.
